Humbly and gratefully we offer this annual as an expression of our deep devotion to our former sponsor, Hulda M. Shepherd.



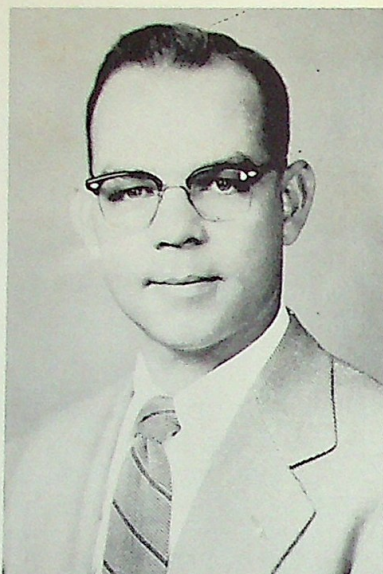

This is our English Department which consists of seven semesters of English and one semester of speech. The instructor is Mrs. Brown.



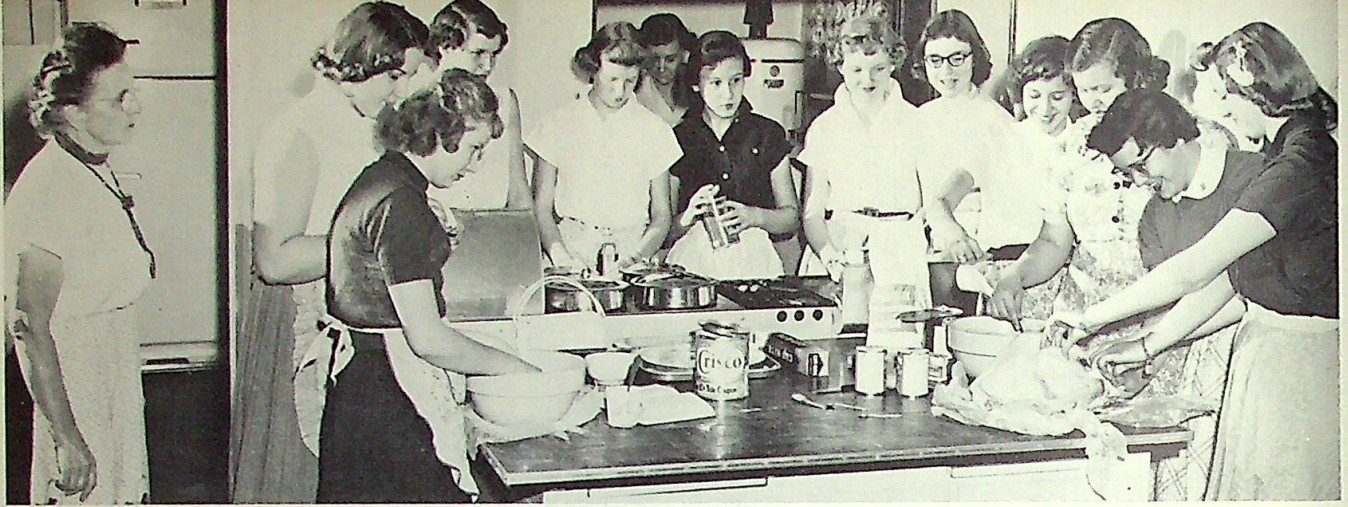
SOCIAL SCIENCE

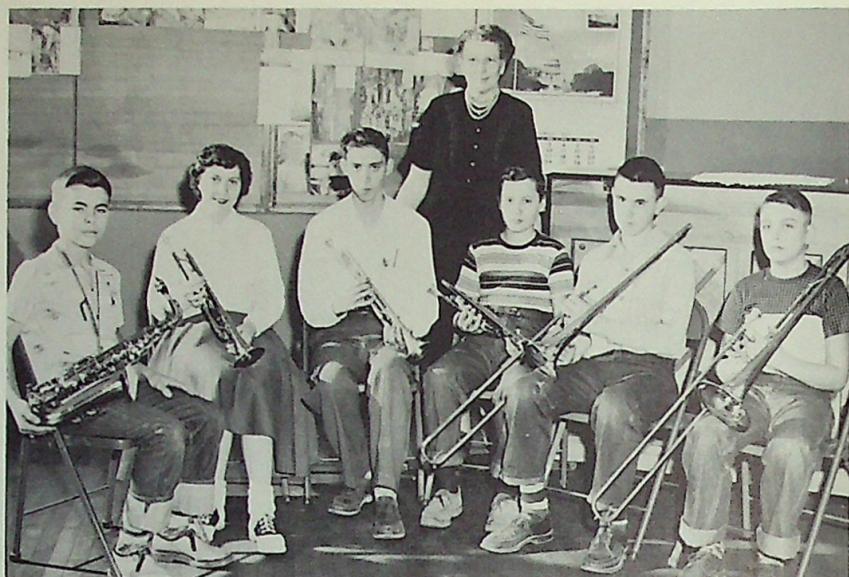


SENIOR SEXTETTE

STUDENT MANAGER

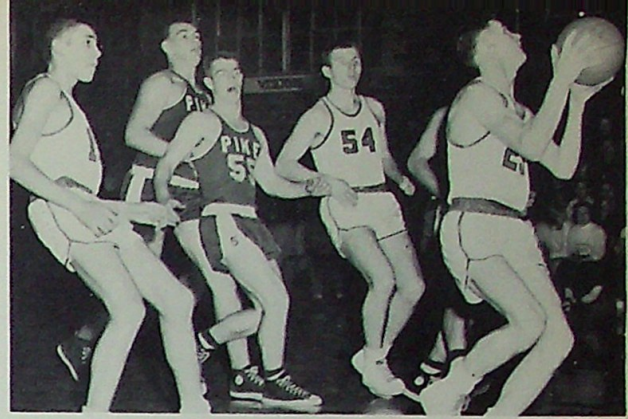
