This is a selected group which was chosen from the High School Chorus. They have made several public appearances this year.

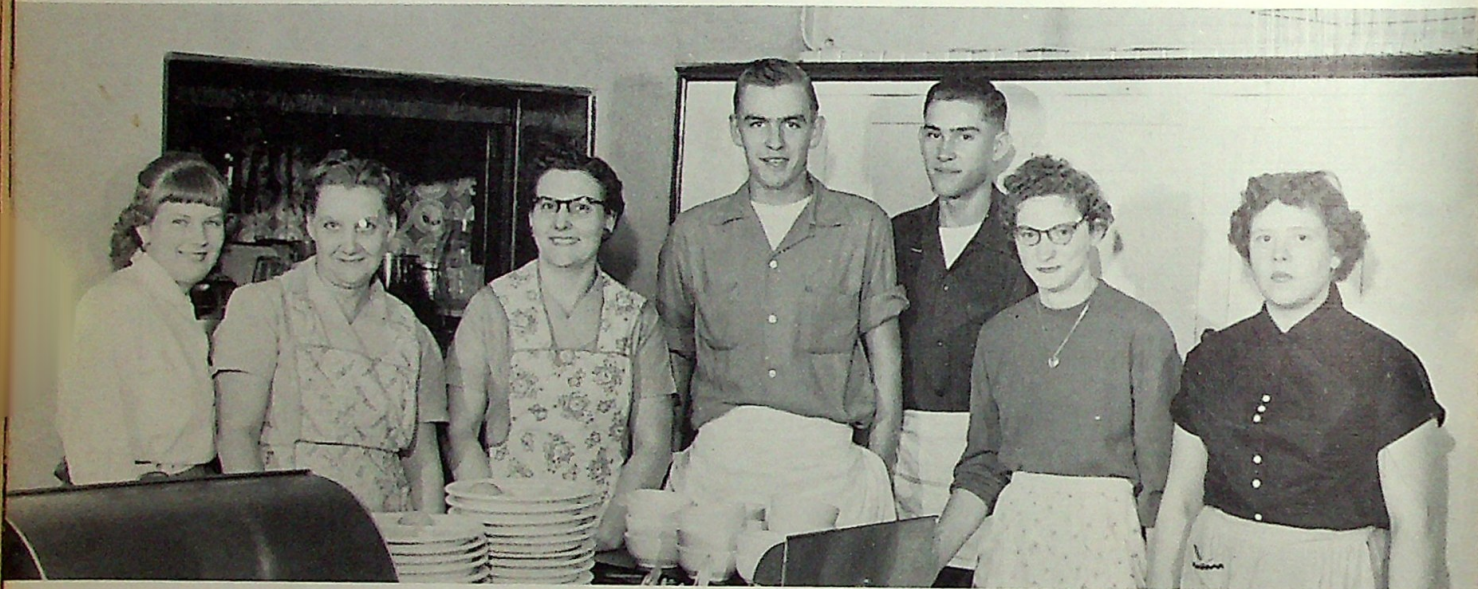


BRASS QUARTETTE

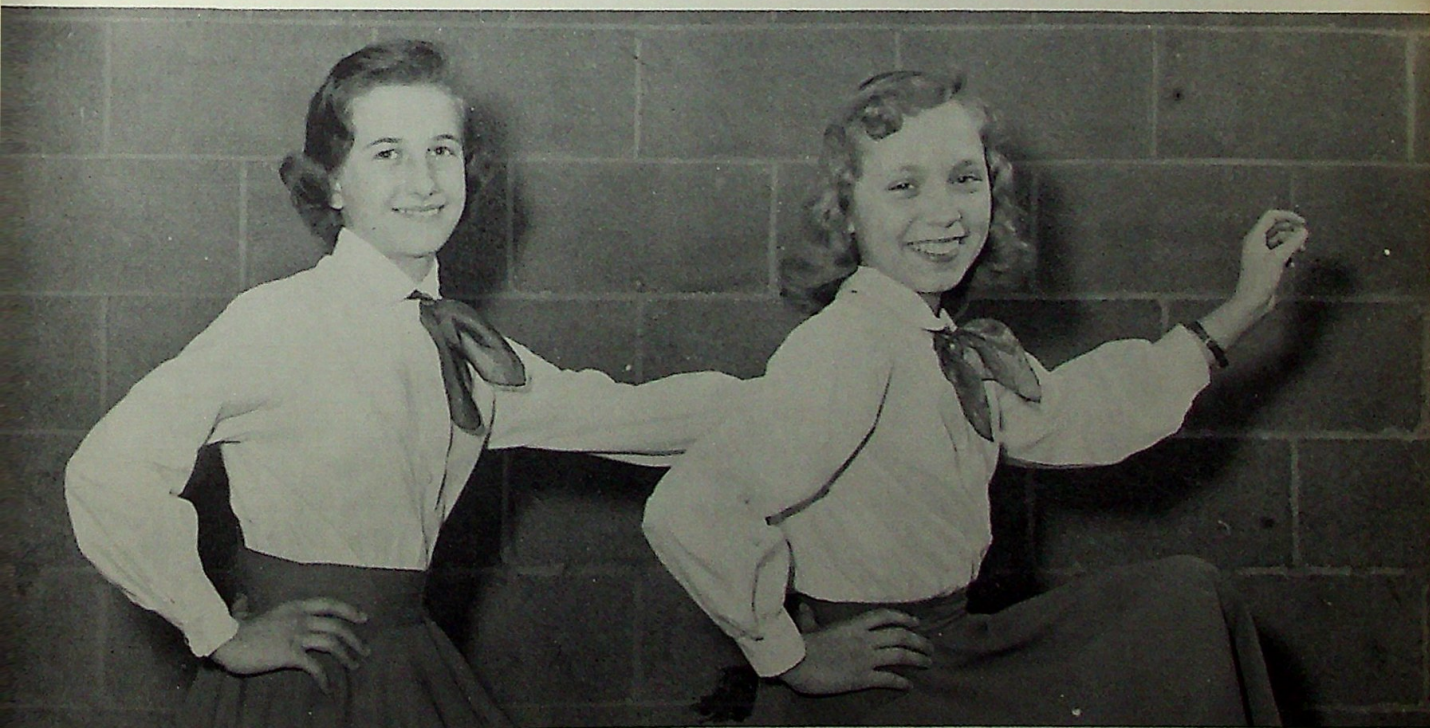


High School Cheerleaders

They were chosen in the same manner as the high school cheerleaders. They are: Kay Van Hook, Linda Dodson.



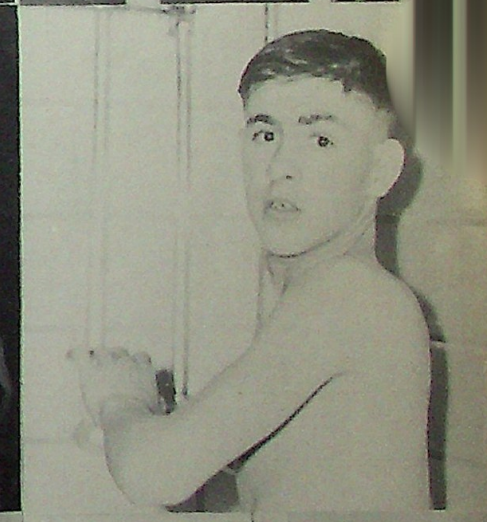
