CLASS HISTORY

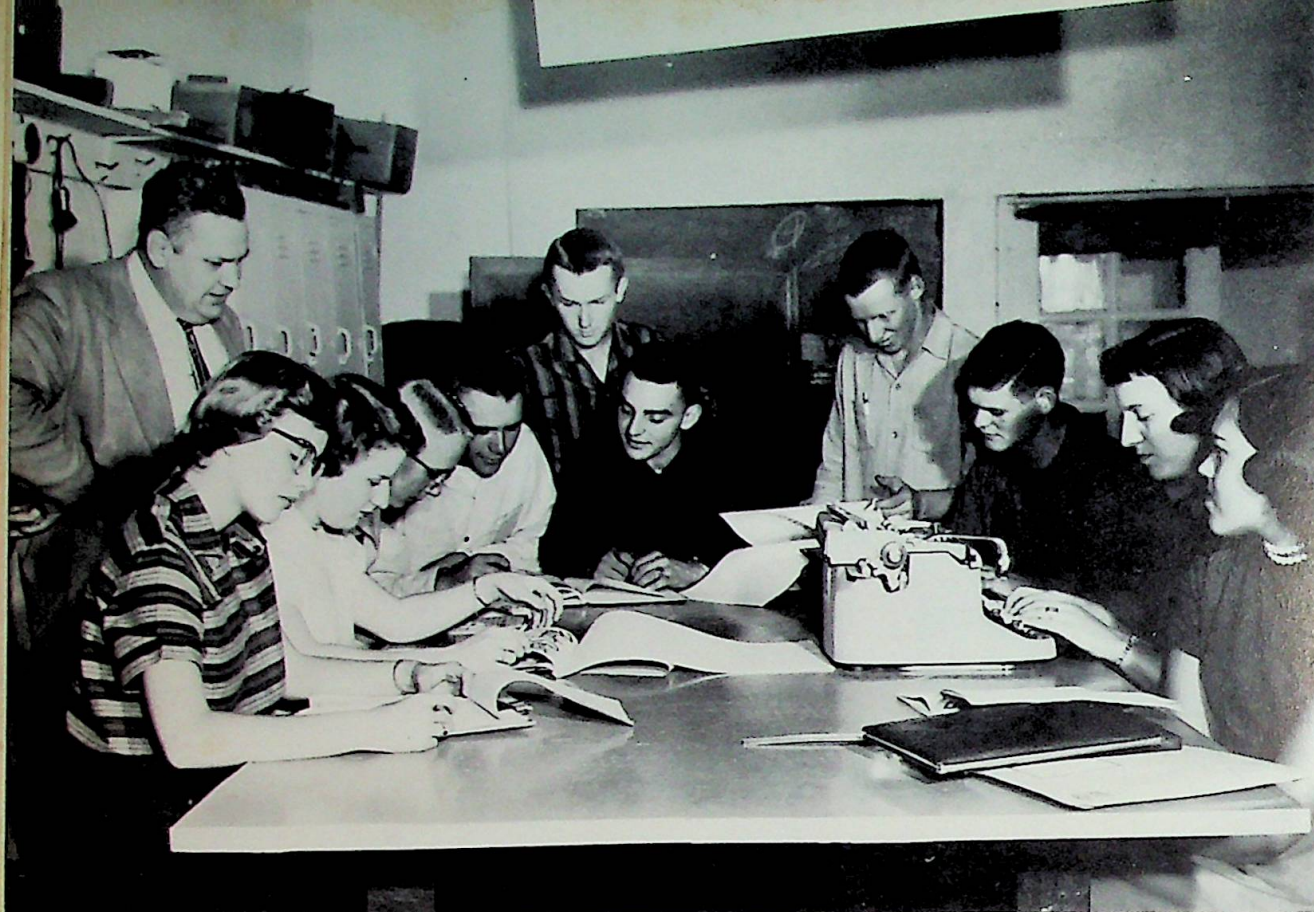

By the end of that year we had not only learned our lessons well but also had acquired blue and white class sweaters. Mrs. Sarah Owens was our sponsor; and the biggest thrill of that year came March 2nd when we saw the Ice Capades in Indianapolis.

Our Sophomore year was one of study and work; but there was a lot of fun mixed in with it, too. How proud we were when we received our class rings! Highlights of that year were our turkey supper, the Pi Delta Kappa play, "Damsels in Distress," and the reception for the seniors in the spring.

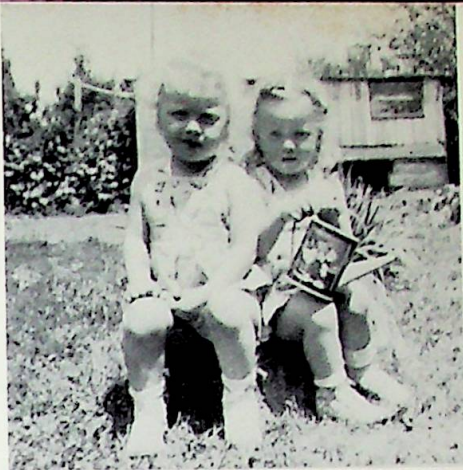


D.A.R. AWARD
