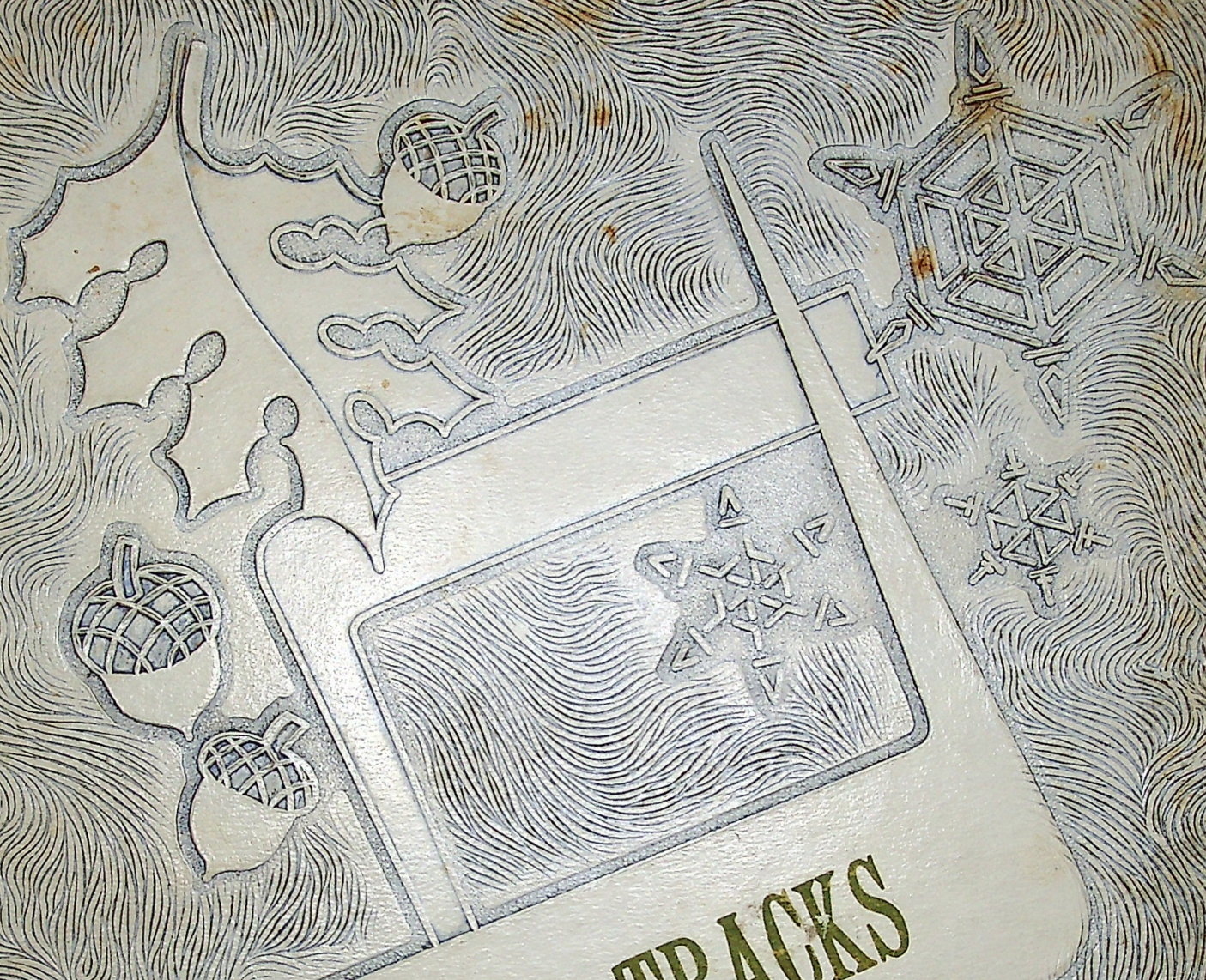

The two efficient gals who work in the office are Jo Powell and Vema Le Galley. Keep up the good work!

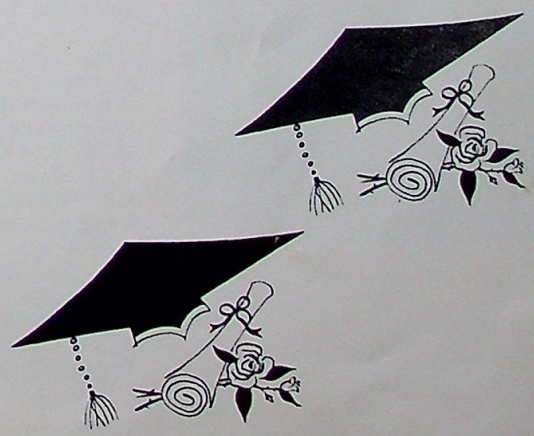

Home Ec.



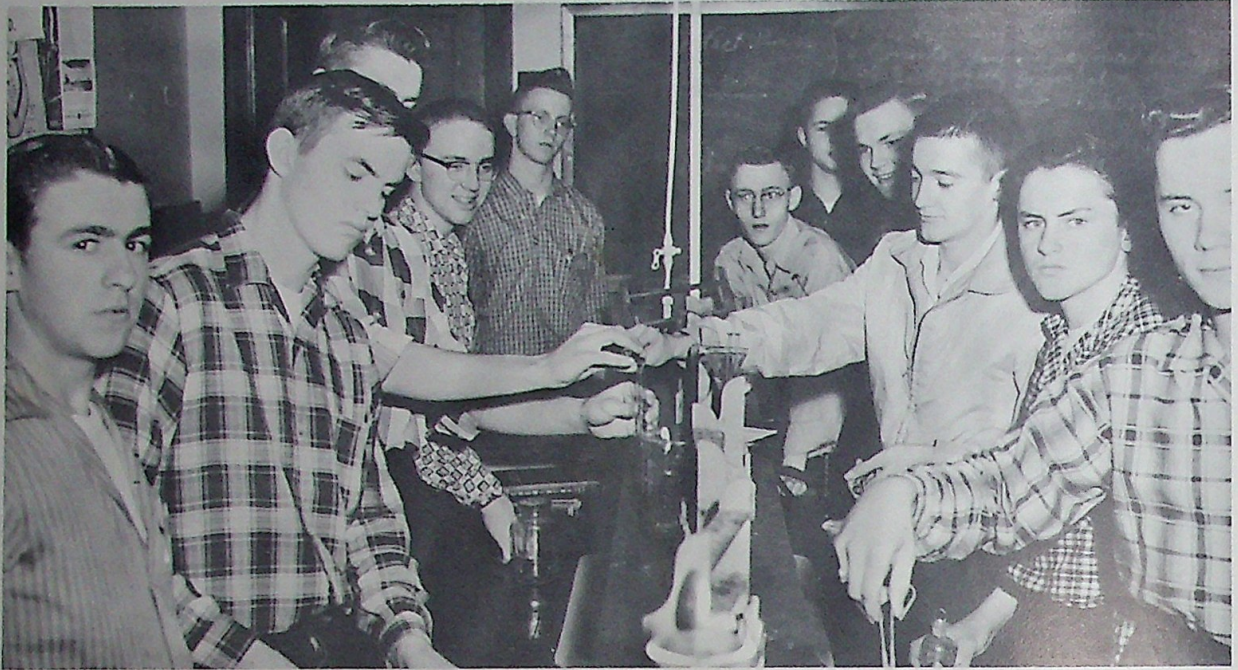

Boys' Phy. Ed.

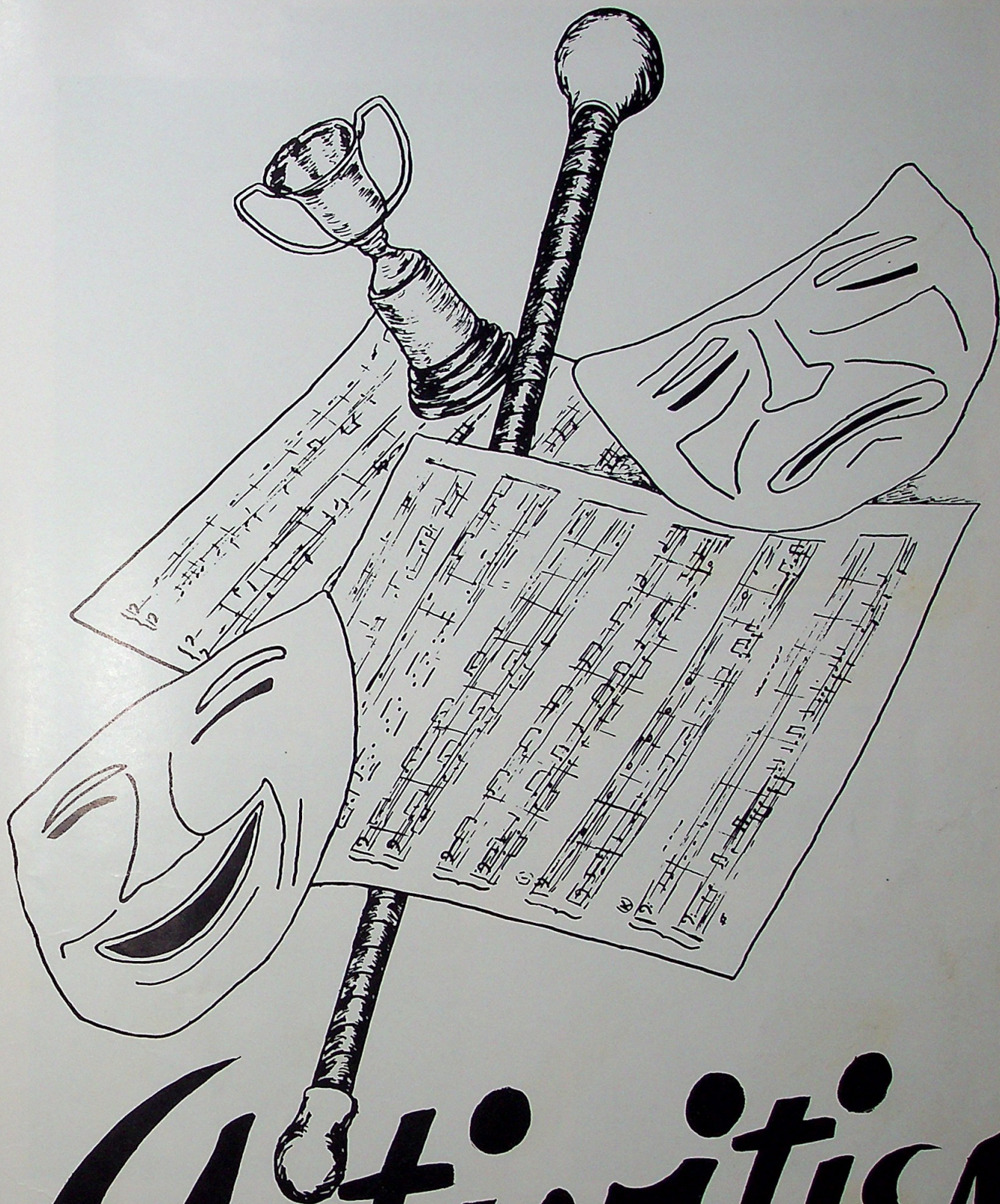

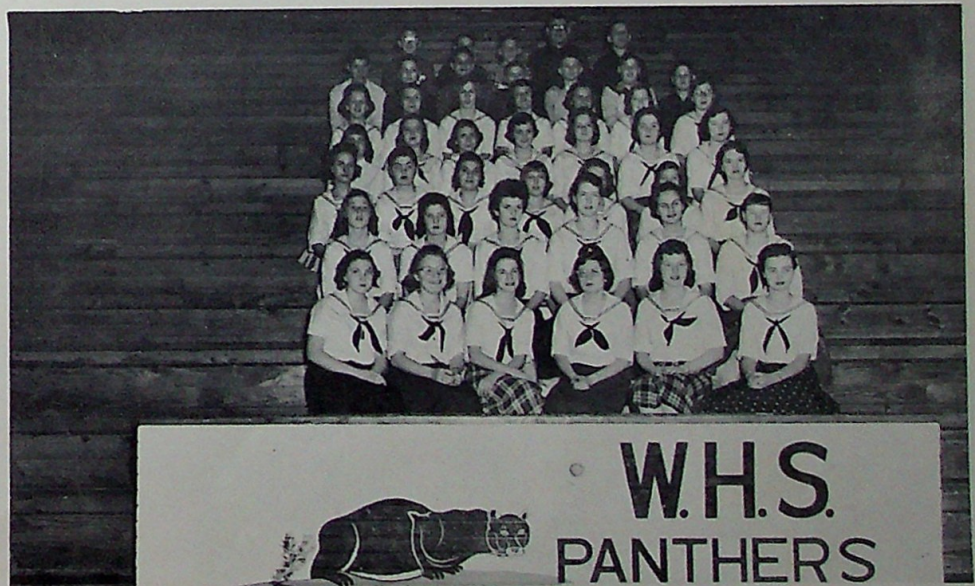


Leggiere Group

My country.

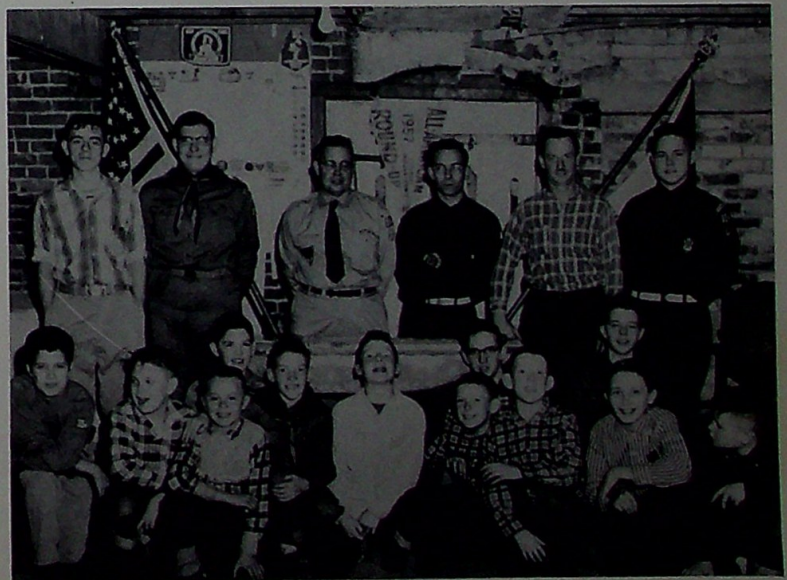


Girls' 4-H

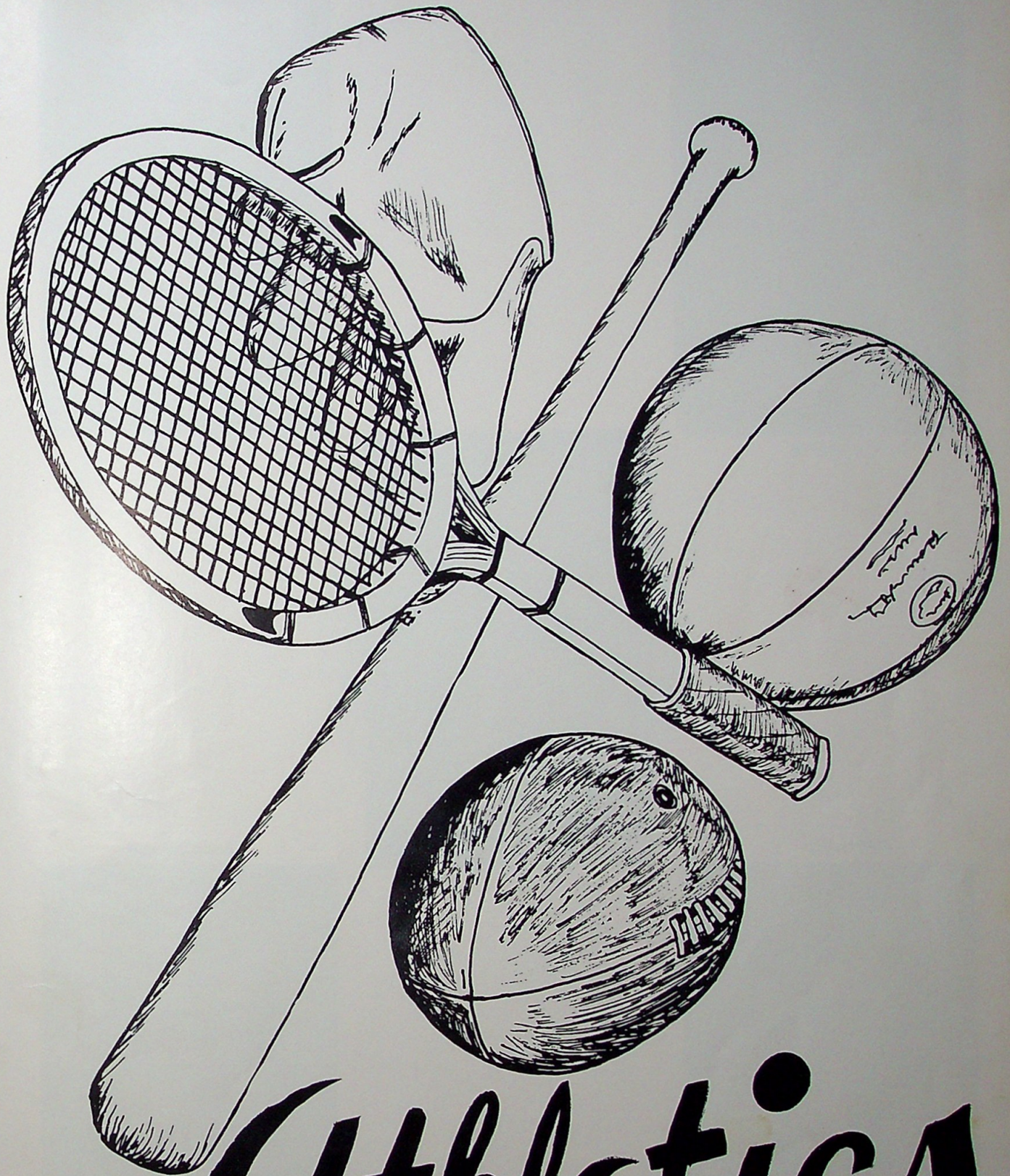
Boy Scouts
