To Speak and Write Correctly

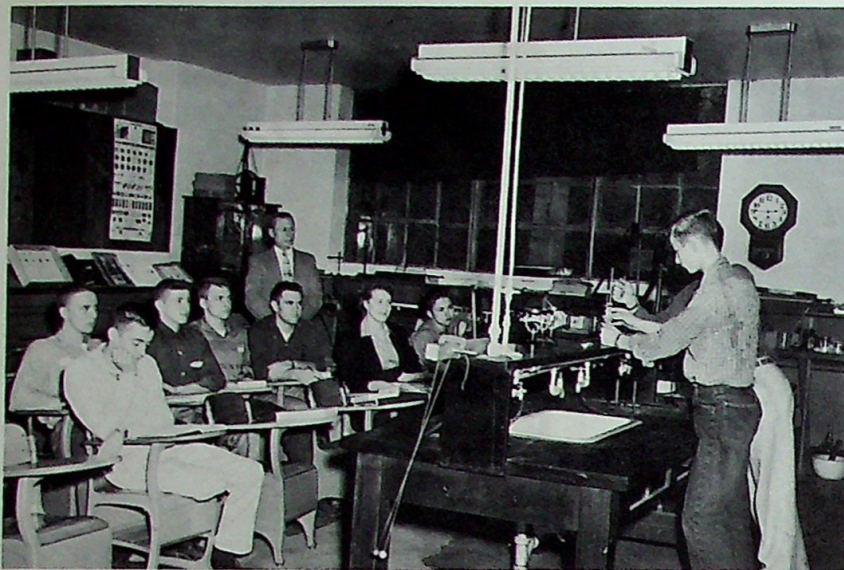
Some of the Seniors are speech conscious with Mrs. Couey assisting them with their articulation.

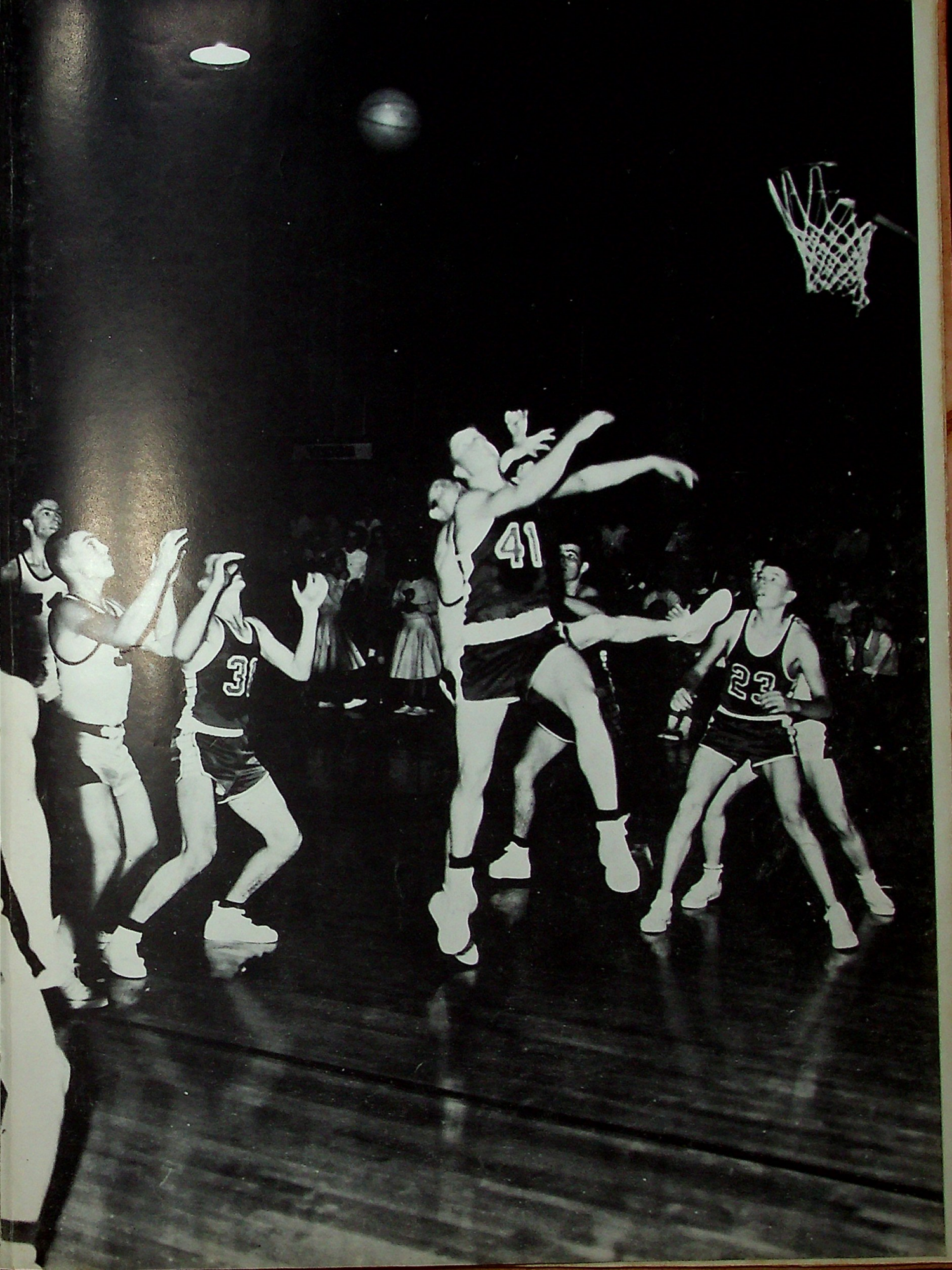
