While driving home, I decided that this is my estimation had been a wonderful day and was one which I would never forget.

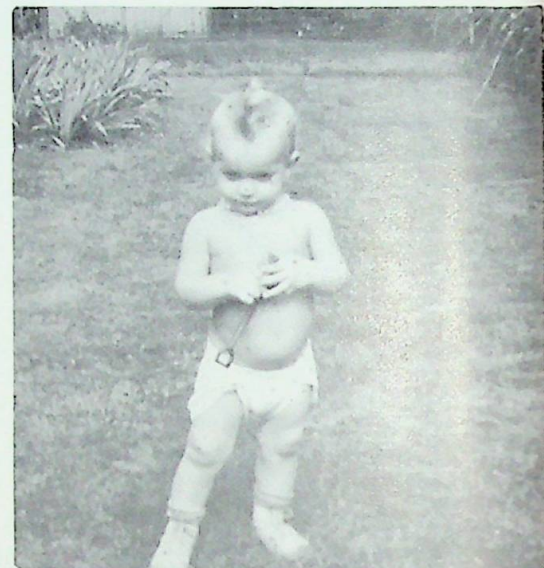

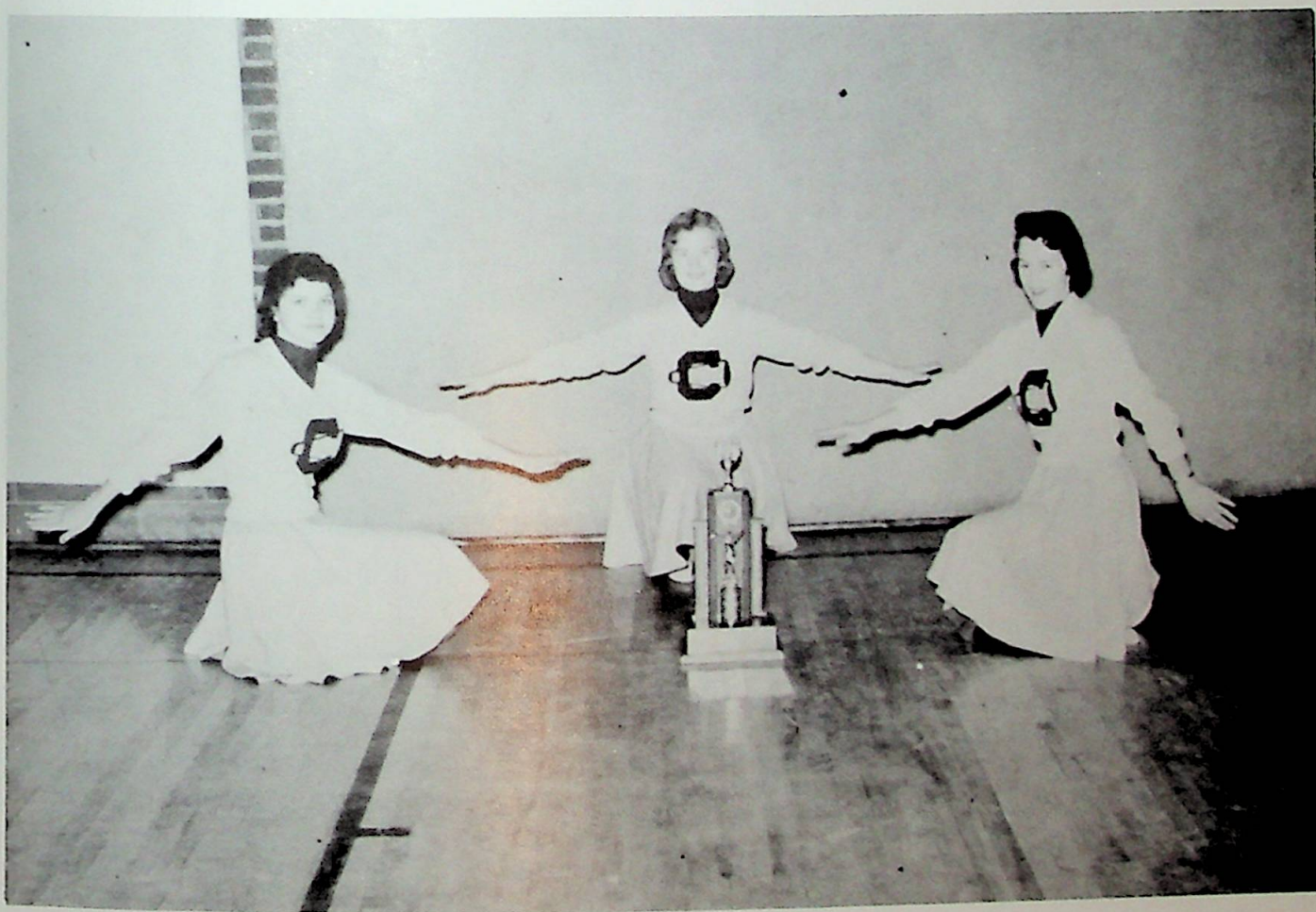




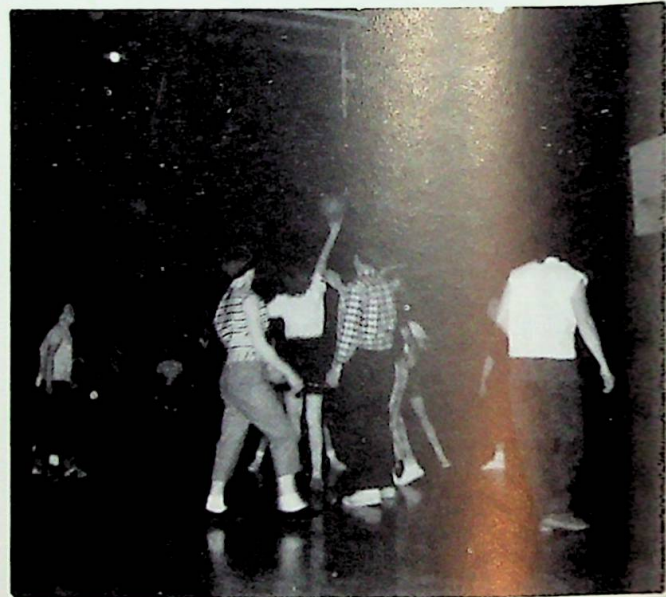


# CHEERLEADING AWARD

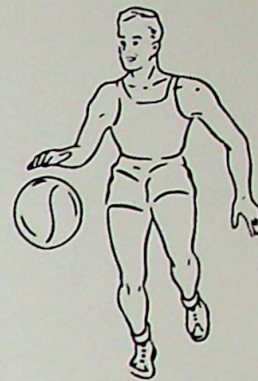

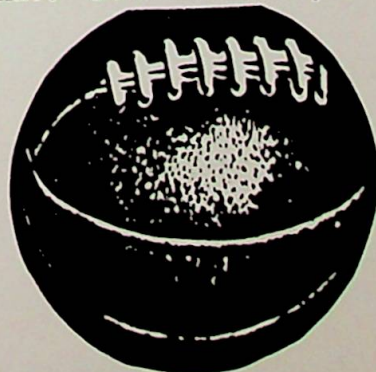
