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OUR GERMAN ANCESTRY

In the late 1600's Germany had been divided into sections, each with its own ruler or king, they were at constant battle with each other over religious and political beliefs. They would war on one another to gain land and power. These people were subject to religious persecutions and lost land and lives. It was during these times that William Penn sent agents into Europe to try to induce them to immigrate to the Penn Colony. Thousands packed up their belongings and made their way across Germany into Holland and to the port of Rotterdam, Holland. From there they began a long voyage by ship to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. So it was by our ancestor, Christian Laughner. By 1776 Benjamin Franklin reported that a third of the people in Pennsylvania were of German descent. This was during a trying time for the people in Pennsylvania. Many Germans were leaving because of a strong Quaker colony whose beliefs differed from the Germans. Many of the Germans started a movement south into the states of North Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia.

This movement later led to the settlement of Worth Township, Boone County, Indiana. How many families started from the state of Pennsylvania is yet unknown, but the records that have been found of name and dates led to my speculation of how they moved from place to place in groups or clans. Information on the Neas, Offinger, Eisenhour, and Henkle families was found in a book of "The Roush Family in America."

In 1834 John Isenhour and William Nease moved into Monroe County, Indiana. Monroe was later to be a stopping off place for others that followed. In 1833 Irenus N. Henkle purchased 171.48 acres of land in Worth Township. Within the next year a group of Lutherans were meeting in the area, almost all of German descent and the majority having come from the area of Eastern Tennessee. Among the early members were the Laughners, Bowers, Harmons, Neese, Bucks, Millers, Peters, Eppers, Henkles, Goods, and the Ottingers and Isenhours were already established. The land grants soon were purchased and others brought up by those that had purchased land between the years 1833-1850.

What brought them into Worth Township, Boone County, Indiana remains a mystery. The land here was far from what they were used to farming. Greene Co. and Monroe Co. is made up of hills much like their home land in Germany. The land here was very flat. It many have been chosen for the purpose of stating up a settlement among the German descent and in all likelihood all were already Lutherans before coming into the area. Most of them were already related through marriage.

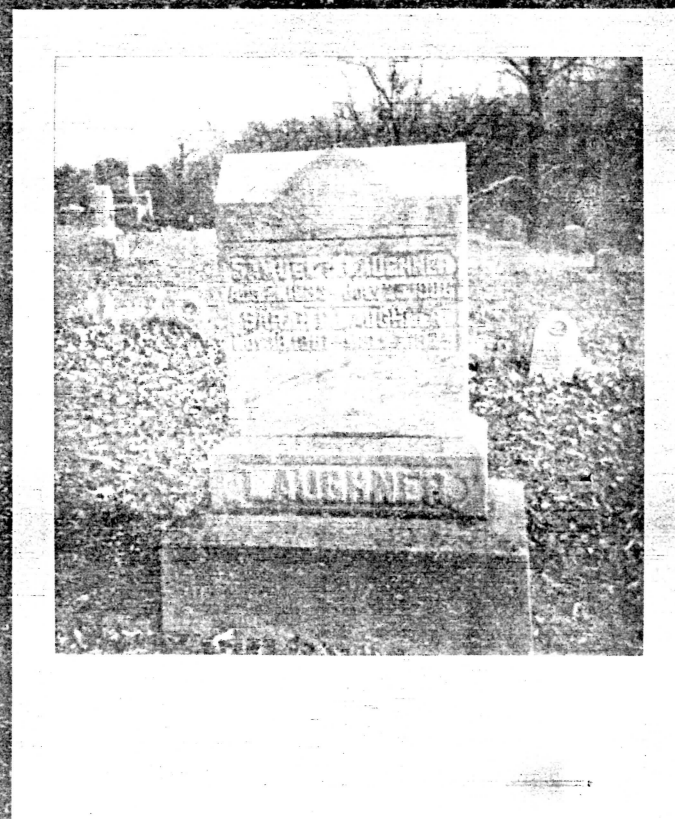
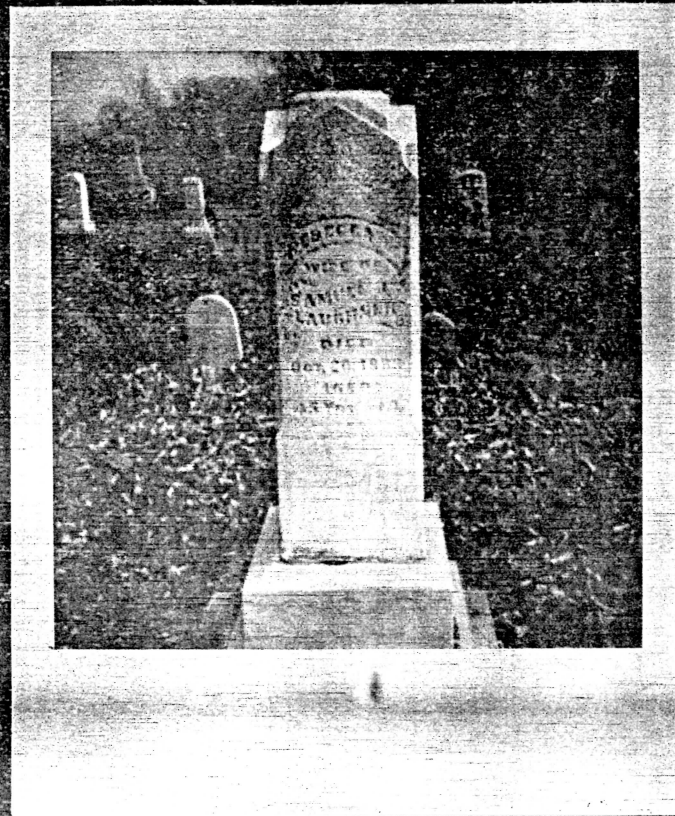

DAIRY PICNIC WILL BE HELD HERE AUGUST 13

PROMOTERS PLANNING TO ENTAIN TEN THOUSAND.

Free Attractions, Free Refreshments and Liberal Prizes for Exhibits of Dairy Stock.

With the hearty co-operation of the chamber of commerce, the Indiana Condensed Milk Company has decided to hold a dairy picnic at Memorial Park, this city, on Wednesday, August 13. While Boone county dairy interests have been growing by leaps and bounds, this will be the first time there has been any effort to bring together for a day those engaged in dairying. Such picnics have been held annually at Sheridan for several years, and have proven of great benefit.

The program for the day is being worked out, the dairy interests co-operating with the chamber of commerce, and will be ready for publication in a few days. In a general way provision will be made for entertaining ten thousand people with such amusement devices as can be secured, including a merry-go-round for the children and such grown-ups as feel young; airplane flights, if it is possible to secure a plane; ice cream and other refreshments. The promoters of the picnic say that whatever is secured will be without cost to the guests, and that every effort will be made to give them the time of their lives.

One of the big features of the day will be a dairy stock show, in which there will be premiums for all classes of dairy cattle. A separate class will be provided for pure-blooded bulls of the several dairy breeds, and there will be a bull sale. No entrance fees will be charged in any of the exhibit classes.

The purpose of the picnic, outside of bringing those engaged in dairying together for a day's enjoyment, is the betterment of the dairy interests of the county.

SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION FOR AUG. 26

Necessity for Appropriations for Maintenance of State Institutions Seems to Be Imperative

According to the Indianapolis Star of today, Governor Goodrich, it is understood, is now making plans for calling the special session of the legislature on Tuesday, August 26. In his original announcement, the governor said he proposed to call the special session either the last week of August or the first week of September.

As many members of the general assembly, who have either conferred with the governor or have written him in regard to the session, have indicated that they prefer an earlier date, it is believed he will acquiesce.

Many of the attorneys, who are members of the assembly, look with disfavor on the September date, as the fall terms of court will convene during that month. They are anxious that the session be called at a time that will not interfere with their plans any more than can be helped.

The governor, before departing for a short trip in northern Michigan Tuesday evening, made inquiries at the offices of the board of public printing to learn how much time would be required for the board to prepare the necessary printed matter and stationery for the special session.

Another reason advanced for the calling of the session in August is that some of the maintenance bills of the state institutions will remain unpaid on August 1, and that it would not be good business to delay the payment of those accounts any longer than necessary.

All the institutions, with the aid of the governor's contingent fund, were able to pay their June bills, but two or three of the institutions will not have enough revenue to meet all their July accounts. A larger number of the institutions will be "broken" in August.

Investigations have been made by the auditor of state's office to see if there is some way in which the deficit created by the institutions during the remainder of the fiscal year, ending September 21, can be met. If

it is said that no way has been found for obtaining legally the funds needed unless an appropriation is made by the legislature.

AGAINST TAX BOARD.

Indianapolis Banking Firm Will Test New Law.

A temporary restraining order against the state board of tax commissioners was issued Saturday by Judge Louis B. Ewbanks, in the Marion circuit court, to prevent the state board from certifying to the county auditor the valuation of the property of the Fletcher Savings & Trust Company, as fixed by the board. The suit involves the methods of valuation, where leaseholds of real estate enter into a concern's property, and is said to be of interest in all parts of the state.

The trust company alleged the valuation arrived at by the state board would, in effect be a double taxation on part of its property as it pays taxes on the real estate and in the valuation the state board included leasehold property.

POSSESSION AND RENT.

Mrs. McMillan Given Judgments by Ex. Bryan.

FIGHT FOR UNIFORM RATES IS IN PROGRESS

The fight of the Indiana business men for uniform rates in the states of Indiana and Illinois is in progress at Chicago before the Interstate Commerce Commission, and Indiana's case has been strongly represented by competent attorneys, employed by the business men of Indiana.

The Indiana State Chamber of Commerce, which has been working on the proposition for some time previous to the hearings, has assessed each business men's organization in the state for a sum of money to carry on this investigation.

The local Chamber of Commerce was given a quota of \$460, which is to be put into a general fund to defray the expenses of the investigation and the employment of men capable

of carrying on the hearing at Chicago.

The evidence that unjust discrimination exists presented to the Interstate Commerce Commission recently is about the same as the facts and statistics that were presented to the local Chamber some time ago by men employed by the state Chamber to place the facts before the business men of the state. Freight rates in Indiana are from 50 to 200 per cent higher than those in use in Illinois, giving the Illinois manufacturer a serious handicap over the Indiana man. Over \$3,000,000 more is spent by the Indiana shipper each year than is expended by an Illinois firm. It is evident that these rates should be modified.

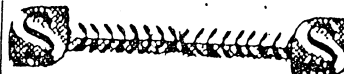
