

MCCORD CEMETERY

Located about a mile and a half south-east of Whitestown in Worth township, Boone County, IN. It is on a hill in a woods on the Booher Farm and is enclosed by a fence with an iron gate. Although many of the stones are overturned, they are still in good condition. The cemetery is no longer cared for.
