A reunion of the Philip Ottinger family was held at Lebanon's Memorial Park in September of 1949, near where the Herr Cabin now stands.

Four sons and five daughters were reared on the Ottinger farm, located 1 1/2 miles west and one mile south of Whites-town. Grandfather Ottinger was an early settler of Worth Township and he cleared the land of heavy timber and farmed until about 1900 when he moved into Whitestown. The farm is now owned by Leland Hackett.
